**Weekly Challenge:**

**Read Psalms Book 3: Chapters 73-89**

- As you read this second "book" of Psalms, underline each verse or line that begins with the word "for" or "because". These verses usually note a reason or reasons for worshipping God. Write out these reasons as you continue to study through the Psalms over the next three weeks.

**WEEK 1 DAY 1**

**TAKE IN: Psalm 73**

**TAKE OUT:**

- What does it mean to wear pride like a necklace? (v.6)
- Does God truly remain the strength of your heart at all times? (v. 26)
- V. 28 ends with a note of evangelism as the author states that he will tell others about the wonderful deeds of God. Take an opportunity this week to tell another about all God has done in your life.

**Weekly Challenge Day 1:** Read Psalms 73-75

**TAKE IN:** Psalm 78

**TAKE OUT:**

- What is the overall theme that develops throughout Psalm 78? (Write down key words or phrases in the Psalm that led you to this conclusion.)
- What was the response of God's people despite all His goodness? (v.40-42) What can we do in our lives so we don't forget what God has done for us?
- Take time to follow through on one of your responses in #2 above. If prayer, take time to pray. If journaling, take time to journal.
