



Are You Kidding Me? Part I

Statement of Faith:

God: There is but one God, infinite in power, wisdom, justice, goodness and love, Creator of the universe, eternally existing in three persons – Father, Son and Holy Spirit – each of whom possesses all the attributes of Deity and the characteristics of personality.

Man: God created man in His own image, and man as he was originally created, was sinless before God. But man chose to sin by disobeying God, and therefore was alienated from his Creator and came under divine condemnation. Thus all human beings are born with a corrupted nature and without spiritual life, and are totally incapable of pleasing God in and of themselves.

TAKE OUT:

TAKE IN: JOHN 1:1-1:34

TAKE OUT:

- *What similarities do you see between Genesis 1 & 2 and John 1?*
- *What does it mean to be created in the image of God?*

WEEK 1 DAY 2

TAKE IN: GENESIS CHAPTERS 3

TAKE OUT:

- *What specifically did the serpent do/say that convinced Adam and Eve to eat fruit from the tree of knowledge of good and evil?*
- *Can you think of another time when Satan did something similar? (Compare Matthew 4: 1-11)*
- *Who do you believe received the worse punishment: Adam, Eve, or the serpent? Why?*

WEEK 1 DAY 3

TAKE OUT:

- *Do you consider yourself to be a good person? Why or why not?*

TAKE IN: Genesis 6:1-7:17

TAKE OUT:

- *How significant was Adam and Eve's sin on the rest of mankind? (Compare Romans 5: 12-19)*

WEEK 1 DAY 4

TAKE OUT:

- *Based on your understanding of Scripture, can you think of 3 or 4 biblical characters who you would consider to be good?*

TAKE IN: Exodus 2; 2 Samuel 11; Acts 8:1; Genesis 20:1-2

WEEK 1 DAY 5

TAKE IN: Psalm 119:1-24

- *Write down any questions you have from any of the reading material this week:*
