STATEMENT OF FAITH:

JESUS CHRIST: God the Father, by His own choice and out of love for sinful men and women, sent Jesus Christ into the world to reconcile sinners to Himself. Jesus Christ lived a sinless life and voluntarily suffered and died as our substitute to pay the penalty for our sins, thus satisfying God's justice and accomplishing salvation for all those who trust in Him alone.

SALVATION: Men and women are freed from the penalty for their sins not as a result, in whole or in part, or their own works, goodness, or religious ceremony, but by the undeserved favor of God alone. God declares righteous all who put their faith in Christ alone for their salvation.

TAKE IN: LUKE CHAPTERS 1 & 2

TAKE OUT:

- When, in history, is Jesus born? Why do you think Luke found it necessary to bring this to our attention?
- Did Jesus exist before He was born? (Compare John 1; Micah 5:2; Colossians 1:15-20)
- Why do you think it is significant that God came to earth in human form?

TAKE IN: PHILIPPIANS 2:1-11; HEBREWS 2:10-15; MATTHEW 17:1-9; MATTHEW 16:13-20

TAKE OUT:

- What evidence do we have that Jesus is fully man?
- What evidence do we have that Jesus is fully God?
- Why did Jesus need to be both God and man?

TAKE IN: JOHN 18:1-19:37 (COMPARE ISAIAH 53)

TAKE OUT:

- Did Jesus voluntarily suffer? If so, what passages show this?
- Had Jesus done anything to deserve this penalty?

TAKE IN: ROMANS 3:23-26; 6:23; MARK 10:45

TAKE OUT:

What was the purpose of Jesus' death?

TAKE IN: MATTHEW 24 & 25

TAKE OUT:

- What does the world look like before Christ returns?
- In one sentence, what do these chapters tell us about Christ’s return?
